40-year collection featured in Rock Island Sept. 8-10 auction

MOLINE, Ill. — Rock Island Auction Co.'s sale scheduled for Sept. 8-10 includes part one of the 40-year collection of Frank and Karen Sellers, featuring the most comprehensive grouping of Sharps firearms offered at auction.

The sale will also offer Winchesters, Colts and U.S., German and Japanese military arms, plus sporting arms and historically significant pieces, and a collection of fraternal badges and insignia. Highlights include John F. Kennedy's M1 Garand National Match rifle; a cased and engraved Winchester 1866 carbine made for the King of Spain, Alfonso XII; and a Colt model 1921 Thompson submachine gun with FBI carrying case and accessories.

Frank Sellers was a featured firearms expert on the PBS series *Antiques Roadshow*, and is the author of numerous books and articles. The Sellers' collection has more than 50 serial no. 1 firearms as well as prototypes, patent models and rare variations. The balance of the collection will be sold by Rock Island on Dec. 8-10. Frank's library of more than 3,000 volumes will be sold at auction over the next year.
